Artist and designer Päivi Raivio has created a site specific installation Tunne+Tila (Sense+Space) in the disused garden of the Seppä's house, just next to the Rauma City Library. The garden and installation in which herbs and edible plants are grown, has been open for public since end of May. Rauma habitants and visitors have been invited to enjoy Raivio's pavilions and the atmosphere of the forgotten garden. Youth from Rauma Street Mission VALO-workshop have been watering the plants during the summer. Now it is time to harvest.
